SUN LAKES FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE RESIDENTIAL LOCKBOXES

Starting January 2007 the Sun Lakes Fire Department will be providing residential lockboxes for residents in the Sun Lakes Fire District. In response to requests from residents, the department has teamed up with Neighbors Who Care to make this service available to the community. Neighbors Who Care Minor Repair volunteers will provide those residents who request it, assistance with the initial installation. On duty Firefighters and EMS personnel will be providing the final installation, securing the key in the lockbox and offering a voluntary home safety inspection.

The boxes are available for only residents in the Sun Lakes Fire District. The initial availability is intended for those residents who may be physically challenged and unable to provide access into their home for the fire department personnel during emergencies.

The boxes will be available for purchase at the Sun Lakes Fire department headquarters, Fire Station #2, located at 25020 S. Alma School Rd. The boxes will cost \$45.00 and be available Tuesday through Thursday (except for holidays) from 9:00 am to 11:00 am and from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm. Final installation and voluntary home safety inspections will be available only on Fridays.

Since there may be a limited number of these lockboxes at any given time, please call 480 895-9343 to inquire about availability before stopping by Fire Station #2.
